

Part Time Job

- If you get "Permission to Engage in Activity Other Than That Permitted Under The Status of Residence Previously Granted", you can work as many as 28 hours a week.
- We can introduce part time job (within 28 hours) for students who come to Japan and not good at speaking Japanese.

Examples

- Convenience Store
- Restaurants or Izakaya
- Translation
- Factory

Important Notice

- 1. More and more foreign students are coming to Japan. There are now 267,042 students in total. The Japanese language level is enhancing accordingly. So we strongly recommend you to study Japanese harder in advance to coming to Japan, not after coming to Japan.
- 2. We have small tests every day at school. So you have to make efforts to acquire Japanese language or you regret coming to Japan.
- 3. The main purpose to come to Japan is studying Japanese. If you come to Japan only for part time jobs, you will be in trouble. Make sure you focus on studying Japanese primarily for your future careers. Part time job is secondary.
- 4. Do not believe such information that you can "earn" money while you are staying in Japan.
 - X ∫you can earn 3000JPY (26USD) per hour」
 - X √ you can "earn" as much as 200,000~300,000JPY while you are in Japan, this amount covers not only tuitions and living costs but also send those money to your home country.
- 5. Those who break Japanese laws or school rules will get serious punishments.
- 6. When you get enrollment permission, make sure you make preparation to go to Japan as soon as possible. If you will be late to go to Japan and miss classes, you have to take supplemental classes to make up for the loss. So you can not start part time job at the appropriate timing.
